

ACQUISITION OF THE STATE LANGUAGE FOR LABOUR MARKET AND INTEGRATION IN THE SOCIETY OF LATVIA

Aim of the programme - to promote the acquisition of the state language and the integration in the society of Latvia.

Target audience - third country nationals and citizens of the European Union.

Length - 120 h per one level of the language acquisition (A, B levels), 20 h course for facilitating the integration; the course consists of 5 modules that can be combined.

Forms of work - on-line classes, in-person /face-to-face classes and independent work; participants receive the study materials, presentations, work sheets, etc.

Module 3.

Acquisition of the state language at B1 level (120 h)

- Reading. Understanding information included in official documents and formal writings.
 Perceiving the main points, plot and essential details
- Writing. Producing a logical and connected text about personal feelings, interests, experiences.
 Writing for everyday needs and producing different types for formal writing.
- Listening. Understanding of the general and topical information included in the text.
- Speaking. Producing a logical, coherent speech about everyday situations, interests, professional activity. Asking precise questions about concrete needs, expressing the personal opinion.

Module 4.

Acquisition of the state language at B2 level (120 h)

- Reading. Understanding texts of thematically diverse genres and functional styles of the language.
 Perceiving directly and indirectly expressed thoughts. Thematics and problems of the text.
- Writing. Producing a logical, precise and coherent text about familiar and less known topics.
 Justification of the opinion/opinions, argumentation and comparison.
- Listening. Understanding the expressed content in different formats about concrete and abstract issues.
- Speaking. Free interaction on different topics.
 Justifying the expressed opinion and giving arguments. Precisely formulated questions to obtain the information.





ACQUISITION OF THE STATE LANGUAGE AND INTEGRATION

Module 1.

Acquisition of the state language at A1 level (120 h)

- Reading. Understanding a simple connected text related to everyday needs and obtaining basic information.
- Writing. Producing a simple text on personal topics: different forms, questionnaires, advertisements, letters.
- Listening. Understanding the heard information if people speak slowly and clearly.
- Speaking. Asking simple questions to get the necessary information. Providing information on personal topics and familiar everyday events.

Module 2.

Acquisition of the state language at A2 level (120 h)

- Reading. Understanding a simple trxt related to areas of immediate personal relevance, catching the main point and most important details. Obtaining information from a simple source of information. Writing. Producing a simple text on personal topics: a greeting card, personal letter, invitation. Putting down in notes the necessary information.
- Listening. Understanding ideas and the information of personal relevance in popular information sources and everyday situations.
- Speaking. Telling about the personal experience, future plans, formulating the opinion and attitude about simple topics. Asking simple questions.





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Module 5.

Integration in the society of Latvia and job environment (20 h)

- History, culture and values of Latvia; state governance and the rule of law (5 h)
- Role of the Latvian language in the job and everyday life; possibilities of spending the leisure time (5 h)
- Society and social life (5 h)
- Social and health care services; possibilities of starting one's own business (5 h)
